What is peer review?

Peer review is a key step in the evaluation of research projects to ensure that they represent feasible, ethical, and applicable projects. Review committees made up of experts in the field come together to review and discuss project applicants and score applications to determine where funding will be allocated.

How can you help?

Those with lived experience bring to the table their own set of expertise, which can be crucial in determining project funding. Is the project exciting for you? Does it represent something meaningful to patients and the community? Does the project engage lived experience partners, and is it written in a way that resonates with you?
