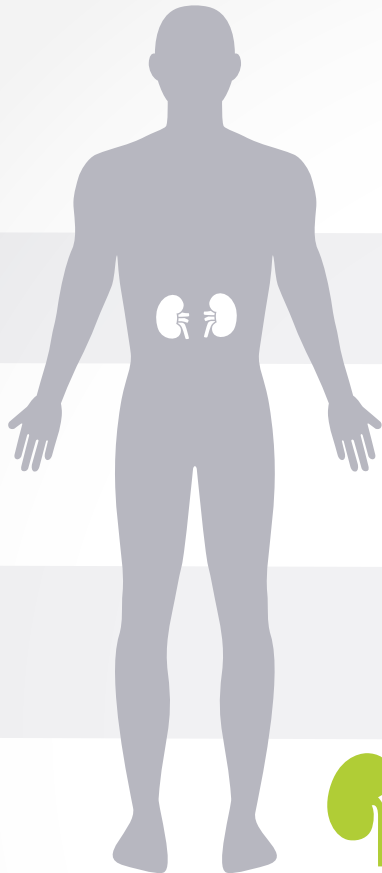


WHY CANADA NEEDS MORE ORGAN DONORS

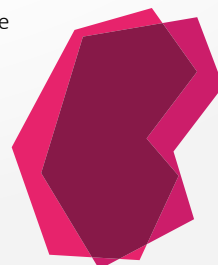
